Robert Michael “Bobby” Dove, 53, of Huntersville, died February 18, 2013 at his home. He was born on April 23, 1959 in Mecklenburg County to Jimmie Jake and Helen Whitley Dove. He was a graduate of North Mecklenburg High School, Class of ’77 and UNC-Charlotte, Class of ’81. Bobby was a member of Huntersville Presbyterian Church, where he sang in the church choir. He also sang in Joe’s Boys and A Girl quartet, as well as the North Meck Community Chorus. He was co-owner of Dove’s Tire Service in Huntersville.

Survivors include his parents, his wife, Janet Davis Dove; daughter Kelly E. Dove of Charlotte; son, Nathan P. Dove of Huntersville; brother Steve Dove and wife Beth of Huntersville and Tim Dove of Huntersville.
