Mrs. Jackie Bonner, 86, of Morehead City, NC passed away Thursday, April 27, 2017. Mrs Bonner has been a resident of NC for most of her life, residing in the Lake Norman area many of those years. For the last four years, she lived on the coast of NC near her daughters.

She has been a member of Northside Baptist Church, Charlotte, NC for the past 60 years, volunteering faithfully in many areas of the church. She was a choir member, Sunday School teacher, Children's Choir Leader, as well as leading Bible clubs in various neighborhoods in the Charlotte area. Mrs Bonner worked in Northside Christian Academy from the school's very beginning in several areas, including being a school bus driver, a kindergarten teacher and daycare director through her years there. Continuing her commitment to children, she worked in the Charlotte Mecklenburg School System at Davidson Elementary School for 25 years, retiring in 2006. Mrs Bonner was preceded in death by her Husband, Ernie Bonner, whom she loved dearly, and her Step Son, Ernie (Bud) Bonner.
