**M**r. Mayberry, 82, lifelong resident of Huntersville, NC, passed away on Thursday, October 6, 2011 at Olde Knox Commons. He was born July 7, 1929 to the late Hollis Kelly Mayberry and Ada Gibson Mayberry. Bob was a 1949 graduate of Huntersville High School, followed by proudly serving in the US Army, where he was stationed in Orleans, France. Upon his discharge, he soon began 32 years of employment with Duke Power Company. During his retirement years, he enjoyed traveling with Christian Tours, tending to his yard, playing his guitar, was a regular at the Hardee's Breakfast Club and was known by family as the "Mayberry Patrol". Bob was a member of First Baptist Church-Huntersville.
