Londees “Lonnie” Davis, Jr., 64, of Huntersville, died November 7, 2011 at Presbyterian Hospital. He was born on July 5, 1947 in Camden, SC to Betty Baskins Davis and the late Londees Davis, Sr. Lonnie graduated from Camden High School Class of '65 and Midlands Tech. He served in the US Air Force 49th TAC Fighter Group/8th TAC Fighter squadron, The Black Sheep. He served in England, Germany, Africa and ended his duty in New Mexico. He was a member of the Cornelius/Lake Norman Lions Club. Lonnie worked for Duke Power (McGuire Nuclear Station) in the engineering department. He was a pilot, loved to fly and loved his friends at the Bradford Airport. He flew an Ercoupe. Lonnie was an avid NASCAR fan.

Lonnie had an accident in 1969 that took his ability to walk but it did not take his love for life or positive attitude.
