Robert Franklin Isenhour, 89, of Cornelius, NC, died Thursday, April 4, 2013 at Lake Norman Regional Hospital.

He was born on November 8, 1923 in Bessemer City, NC. He was the son of the late Thomas "Frank" and Mary "Lizzie" Best Isenhour, and the husband of the late Mavis Singletary Isenhour. He was a US Army Veteran of WW II where he served with the 1st Division of the 16th Infantry at Normandy Beach during D-Day. He was a jeweler, watch maker and retired from the US Postal Service in Charlotte.

Survivors include three daughters, Joy Isenhour of Cornelius, Gay Griffin and husband Jim of Charlotte, and Robbie Isenhour of Mooresville; three grandchildren, Angela Griffin and husband Wes Hodgkin, Katie Griffin and Anna Pannebaker and husband Aaron; two great-grandchildren, Helen Grace Hodgkin and Laurel Elise Hodgkin; numerous nieces, nephews and cousins.
