Dr. Michael T. Wilson, 54, of Huntersville died April 22, 2014 at Presbyterian Hospital in Charlotte. He was born on November 23, 1959 in Princeton, WV to Patricia Ann Wilson and the late Thomas C. Wilson.

Michael was a beloved husband and father who never failed to bring the love of Christ into the lives of everyone he met. He served the Lake Norman community as a dentist for 22 years.

In addition to his mother, survivors include his wife Kim Wilson; sons, Mike of Charlotte and Nick and Andrew of Huntersville; brother Mark Wilson of Beckley, WV and Tamera Scurry of Sumter, SC.
