William “Bill” Orr Brown, Jr., 84, of Huntersville, died December 23, 2011 at the NC State Veterans Home. Mr. Brown was born May 17, 1927 in Huntersville, the son of the late William Orr Brown, Sr. and Minnie Christenbury Brown. He was a member of the Huntersville A.R. Presbyterian Church serving as an Elder, Deacon, Sunday School Teacher, Congregational Chairman, and a Trustee. He was an active Gideon since 1972. He was a Founding Member of the Loch Norman Highland Games. Mr. Brown was a Navy veteran serving in World War II. Mr. Brown was a graduate of Huntersville High School and the International Architectural School.
