**R**enee Jeannine Frizzell of Cornelius, NC and formerly of Zephyr Cove, NV passed away unexpectedly on May 8, 2018 in Cornelius, NC. She was 63.

Renee was born at Ft. Meade, MD on September, 2 1954. She was the only daughter of the late Harry Putman Frizzell and Mary Jeannine Frizzell.
