Lynne worked at Carolina Case Managers, where she was a vocational rehabilitation counselor. She graduated from Richland Northeast HS, Columbia, SC, in 1983. She went on to Clemson University and then obtained her masters in education from USC. Lynne was involved in the Logos program at First Presbyterian Church, Mooresville. She was a great mom to her 3 children and a great aunt to her 10 nieces and nephews. She often volunteered for her children's school.

Survivors include her husband Scott Swing; children, Luke, Ben and Katie, all of Mooresville; brother Rodney Reading and wife Betty Sue of Davidson and Bryan Reading and wife Wendy of Davidson. Her brother Barry preceded her in death in 2004.
