**J**oseph Glenn Trifiletti, 66, of Charlotte, passed away Thursday, August 3, 2017 at Novant Health Matthews Medical Center. A native of South Carolina, Joey lived in North Litchfield Beach prior to recently relocating to Charlotte.

Joey was born in Columbia, SC and grew up in Florence, SC, where he was an Eagle Scout. He earned his Bachelor of Science and Mathematics degree from the University of South Carolina, where he was elected as a member of both Phi Eta Sigma and Phi Beta Kappa honor societies. He was also a member of Lambda Chi Alpha fraternity. Joey later received a Bachelor of Science in Pharmacy degree from the Medical University of South Carolina, where he was selected to be a member of the Rho Chi Society.
