Kathryn Lynn Trainor Davis, 58, passed away September 25, 2015, from lung cancer in Charlotte, NC.

Kay was born July 10, 1957 in Douglas Georgia. She was a proud graduate of Shelby High School, NC and the University of North Carolina at Greensboro where she was a member of the elite Phillips-Hawkins Society.

She was multitalented and had an engaging personality that led her to excel as a flight attendant for Piedmont and US Airways.

It was that engaging personality that captivated her husband of 22 years Scott Davis, a Commander in the Navy, when first he met her on a flight. It didn't take long for them to be married at the Myers Park Methodist Church in Charlotte, NC.
