**J**effrey William Cozy, 53, of Huntersville, NC passed away on Wednesday, September 30, 2015 at Novant Presbyterian Hospital in Charlotte, NC.

He was born on February 19, 1962 in Charleston, SC and was the son of the late John Francis Cozy. He was a 1980 graduate of Antelope Valley High School in Lancaster, CA where he was the quarterback of the varsity football team; 1984 graduate of Chico State University and member of the Phi Kappa Tau fraternity; was past Exalted Ruler of the Benevolent & Protective Order of the Elks in Hillsboro, OR; Senior Mortgage Underwriter for Bank of America in Charlotte; and attended Community in Christ Church in Huntersville.
