Terrell Keith Dale of Huntersville, NC passed away on July 7, 2014 after a long illness. He was born on August 27, 1947 in Dalhart, TX to Fern Moss Dale and the late Robert L. Dale and raised in Pryor, OK with his three siblings, Gary Dale (Margaret), Charles Dale (Judy) and Pamela Migliaccio (Richard). TK volunteered for service in Vietnam.
