Vicki Kidd Tucker, 68, of Statesville, formerly of the Rockin K Ranch, Charlotte, passed away peacefully at her home on Wednesday morning, October 12, 2016. Vicki was born on January 3, 1948 to C.W., Jr. and Helen Kidd in Charlotte, NC. She was raised on the Rockin K Ranch and was a graduate of N. Meck. High School, class of 1966. She married her high school sweetheart and was the loving wife to her husband Scott for 50 years. She worked side by side in the family business at the Mecklenburg Abattoir and also owned the Rockin K Western Store for several years. She was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church and lifetime member of the Southern Rodeo Association, where she won multiple barrel racing championships. She shared her passion for horses and rodeos with her family and loved nothing more than going to the rodeo to watch her grandkids compete. Vicki will be missed greatly by her family and many friends that loved her. She was a precious mother, grandmother and friend.
