James Funeral Home of Huntersville is serving the family of Nicholas and online condolences can be made to jamesfuneralhomelkn.com.

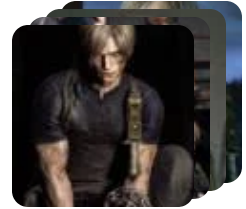
