Douglas A. Kydd, Jr., 89 of Denver, NC, previously from Bellmore NY, died November 13 at Olde Knox Commons. In between graduating from Brown University and Boston University School of Law, he spent time in the Pacific Ocean area as a United States Navy Officer.
