Oliver Lloyd Johnston, 89, of Huntersville died November 8, 2013 at his home. He was born on September 17, 1924 in Mecklenburg County to the late Loyd Wilson and Bessie Head Johnston. He was an Aviation Machinist's Mate, Third Class in the US Navy aboard the aircraft carrier USS Cabot during WWII, serving in the Pacific Arena. He was a lifetime member of First Baptist Church-Huntersville and a contributing founder of the East Huntersville Mission. He retired from Pneumafil Corp after 35 years of employment.
