Kathy Byrum Hybarger, of Huntersville, passed away at the age of 65 early on the morning of Monday, September 24th, 2018 at Novant Presbyterian Medical Center in Charlotte, NC.

A service to celebrate her life will be held at 1:00 pm Thursday, September 27th in the chapel of James Funeral Home in Huntersville, NC with a reception to follow in the James Funeral Home Community Room. Reverend Mike Davis of Real Life Church in Stanley, NC will officiate.

Kathy was born in Charlotte, NC on January 5, 1953 to the late William Peck and Joyce Cauble Byrum.
