James Funeral Home is serving the family locally.

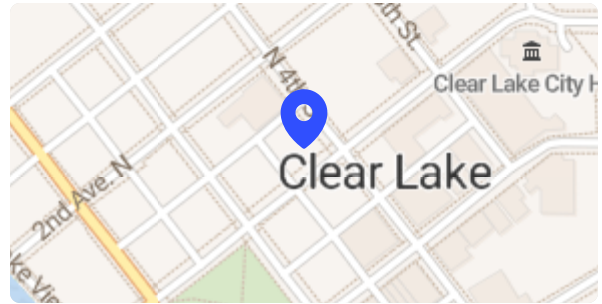
