Fred Stewart and Mary Elizabeth Stewart, both deceased. 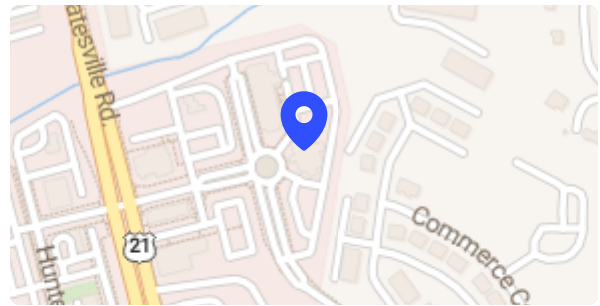

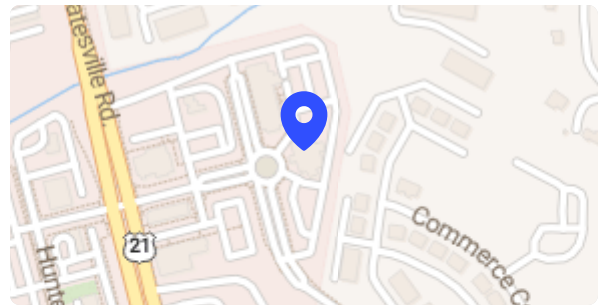

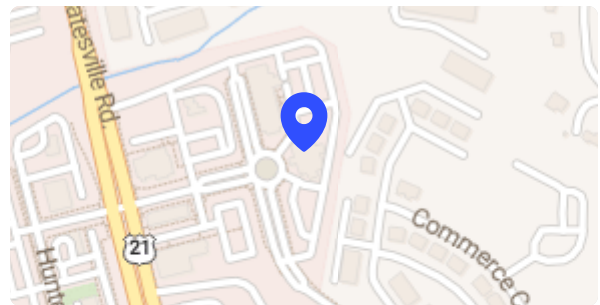
