Reverend Frederick Paige Guy, age 72, died on Tuesday, October 22, 2019, at Autumn Care in Cornelius. He was born on October 14, 1947, in Newport News, VA to Mable Morgan Guy and the late Alma Paige Guy.

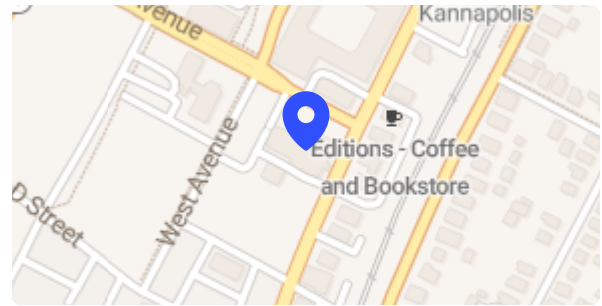

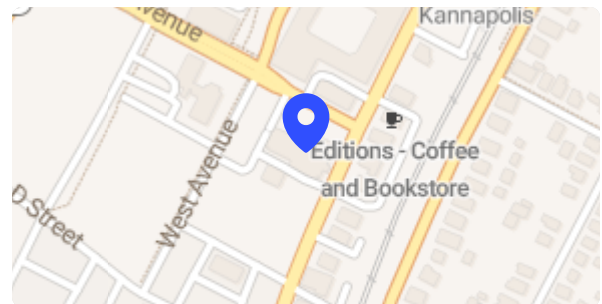
