JAN 1, 1935 - OCT 26, 2019

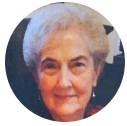

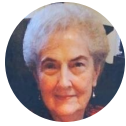
All that being said, first and foremost Carole's family was her highest priority. There was no greater love than the love she had for her family.
