On Sunday, March 1st, Lawrence John Blecka, a loving husband and father passed away at the age of 75. Lawrence was born on September 19, 1944, in Chicago, Illinois to John and Antoinette Blecka. He was a graduate of St. Patrick's High School. Lawrence received his bachelor's degree from Lewis University and a master's degree from Northern Illinois University. After earning his PhD in parasitology from Southern Illinois University, Lawrence taught at the University of Illinois School of Medicine, published a textbook in his discipline, and worked for various biotech companies throughout his career. On August 9, 1969, Lawrence married his wife of over 50 years, Margaret Louise Hornyak. 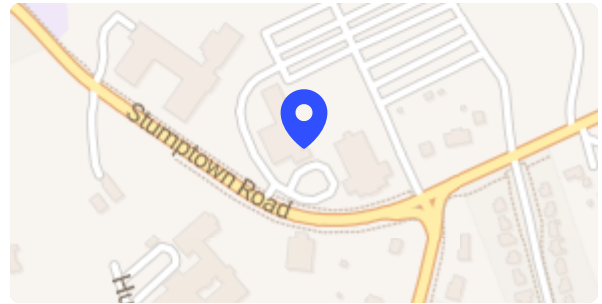

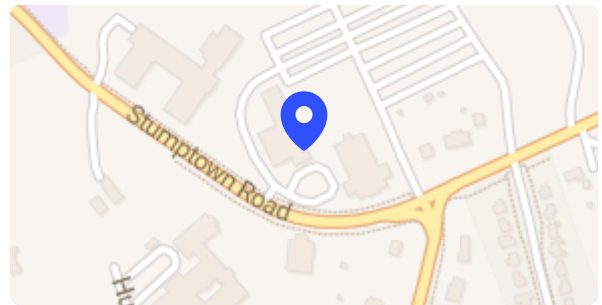
