**N**ancy Harwell Brown entered the gates of Heaven on May 15, 2020. After a recent cancer diagnosis she succumbed to complications. She was born at her grandmother's home in Long Creek to Rolandus and Edna Harwell on July 30, 1936.

Nancy is a graduate of North Mecklenburg Highschool Class of 1954. While attending North Meck in 1951 she met her sweetheart Don in the school hallway and their love story began. After Don returned from the Korean War they married in 1955 at Pleasant Grove United Methodist Church. On April 9, 2020 they celebrated their 65th Wedding Anniversary.

As a faithful Christian, Nancy read her Bible daily and practiced the word of Gospel sharing kindness and love for others. An active member of Circle #3 and Young at Heart at Trinity United Methodist Church.

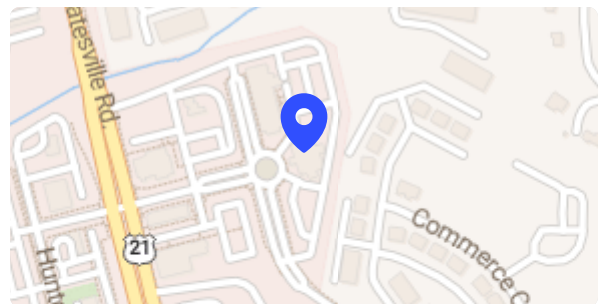

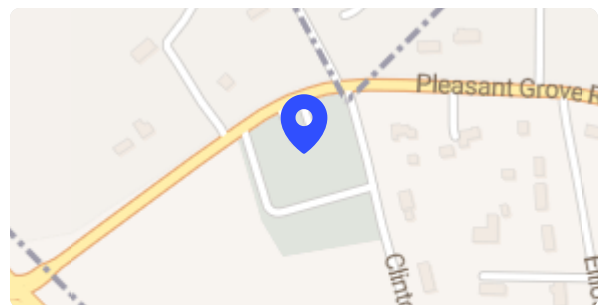
