Barbara, who was a retired nurse, spent her life caring for others. 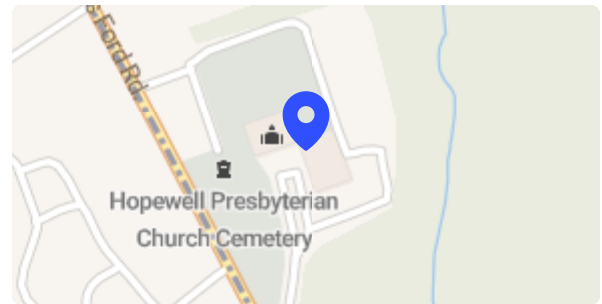
