A private family graveside will be held at Prosperity Presbyterian Church.




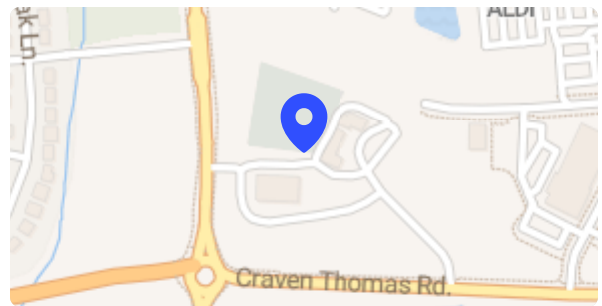
