## Angel Bonilla

**A**ngel Bonilla, 83, of Charlotte, went to his heavenly home on May 18, 2021. Angel was a humble man who loved the Lord, his family, church and native island of Puerto Rico.

Angel was born on September 4, 1937 in the town of Camuy, Puerto Rico to Pedro and Maria Bonilla in a Christian home. Angel, who was also known as William, began working at a very young age in the sugar cane fields of his native Puerto Rico. He was one of seven children and at the age of 20, Angel moved to New York City in search of a better life. While there, he met his beloved wife, Miriam, whom he was married to for 55 years. Angel and Miriam lived in various cities including The Bronx, NY, Boca Raton, Fl and Charlotte, NC. before retiring back home to Lares, Puerto Rico.
