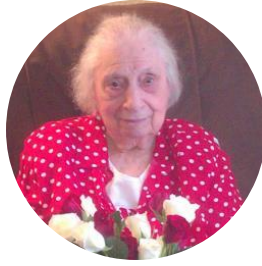

Her favorite motto was "No sense of complaining, no one is listening" she would make us all laugh.

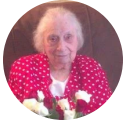
In addition to her parents, Catherine is predeceased by her husband, Guido Derespinis; son, John Derespinis; and brother, Frank Mecca.
