Craig Alan Kachline, 74, of Stanley, NC passed away on Saturday, June 19, 2021, at Levine & Dickson Hospice House at Aldersgate in Charlotte, NC. He enjoyed a long and productive life as a husband, father, brother, grandfather, brother-in-law and good friend.

He was born in East Cleveland, OH and resided in Stanley, NC since 2003. Craig retired in 2000 from Dephi Automotive Systems division of General Motors as a manufacturing Supervisor at the Euclid Ohio Plant and as Purchasing Agent from Dephi Corporation Division of GM after 30 years of service.

Craig was an Army Veteran serving in the 5th Battalion, 27th Artillery during the Vietnam War.

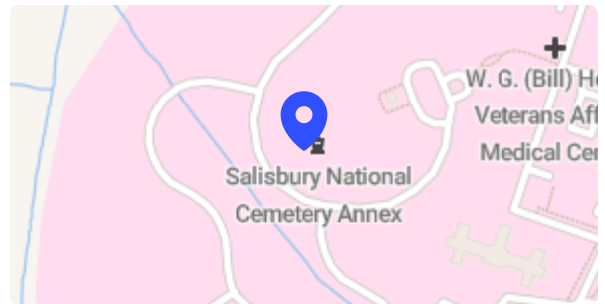
