Followed by mass at 11:30 AM. The burial will follow at Belmont Abbey.

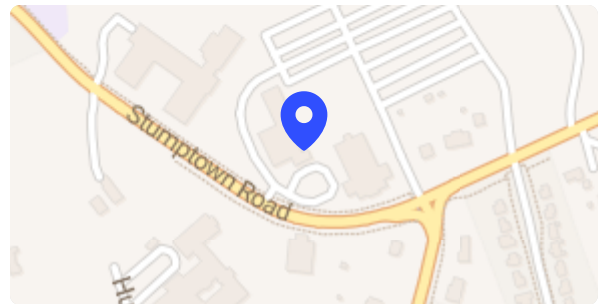

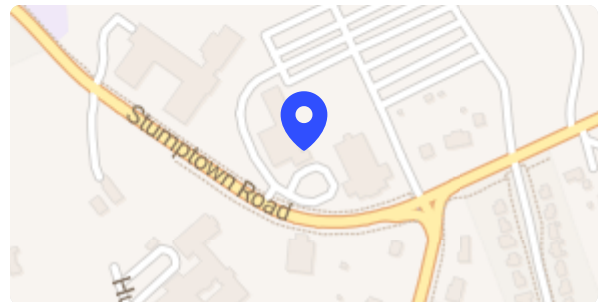

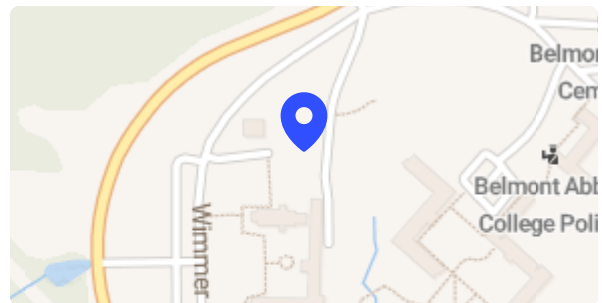
