Sumpter Lamont Bass was born on September 3, 1979 in Charlotte, NC. He departed his life on Monday December 20, 2021 at home surrounded by his close family and friends.

Lamont graduated from Providence High School in Charlotte, NC and went on to Catawba College to study Sports Management. During his school career he was an avid football and baseball player. He was one of the biggest Dallas Cowboy and Duke fans you would ever want to meet. Lamont would never turn down a good game of spades and didn't mind hitting the lanes on Sunday for a skillful game of bowling. Anybody that knew Lamont knows that his most favorite places were on the back of his lawnmower and with his family. Lamont was the sole proprietor of "Kut N Edge" Lawn Service where he built his business from the ground up and served hundreds of customers across Charlotte and surrounding areas. 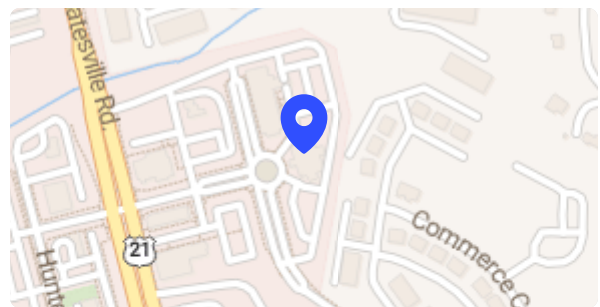

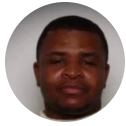
