# Annie Mae Styers

MAR 4, 1929 - JAN 30, 2022

**A**nnie Mae Gibson Styers, 92, of Huntersville, died January 30, 2022. She was born to the late Marion and Bessie Mae Jones Gibson on March 4, 1929 in Huntersville, NC. She was baptized as a baby and was the oldest lifelong member of Huntersville Presbyterian Church. There, she was a member of the Ladies Bible Study and the Present Word Sunday School Class. Annie Mae was a 1947 graduate of Huntersville High School, earning the honor of Valedictorian. She was an original member of the Red Hat Club of HPC. She retired from North Mecklenburg High School as an assistant librarian.

She was preceded in death by her husband of 58 years, Everett Styers.

James Funeral Home of Huntersville is serving the family.

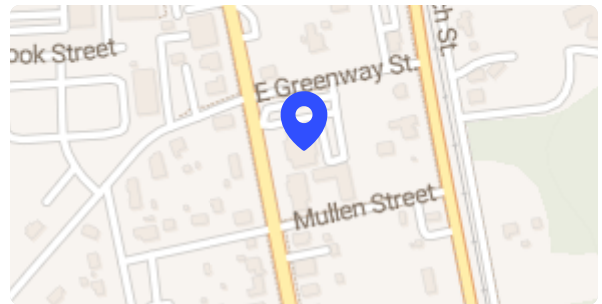

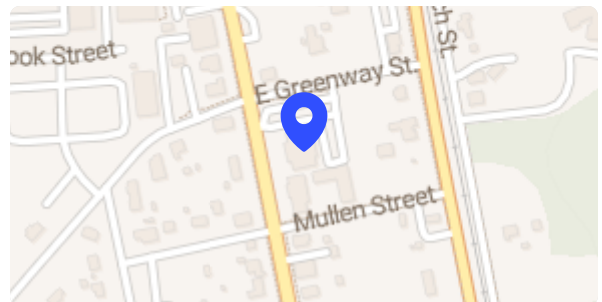

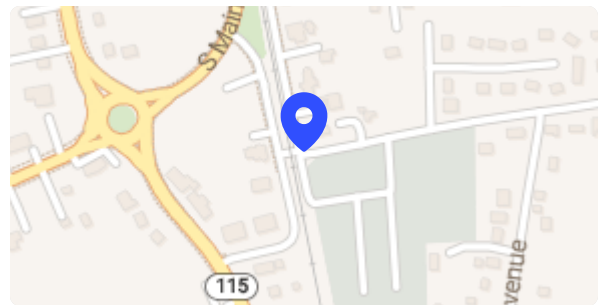
