Frankie Poole Bost, 93, of Charlotte, North Carolina died June 2, 2022.

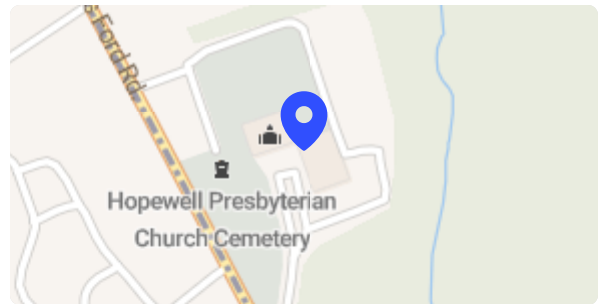

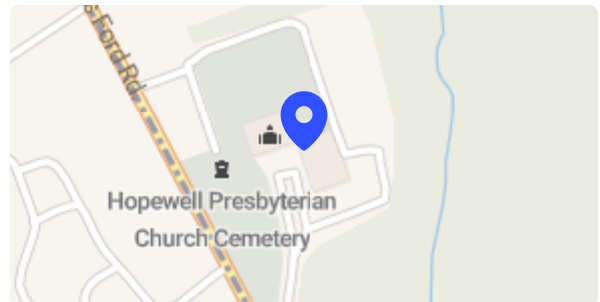

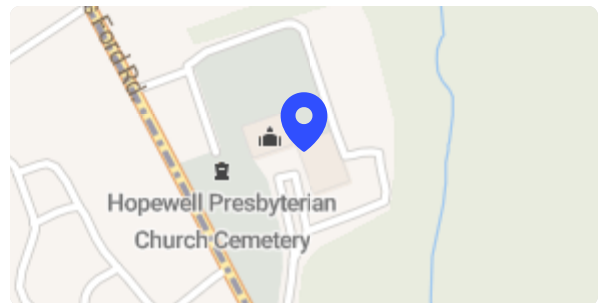
