Chad Aaron Williams, 53, of Charlotte, North Carolina, passed away far too soon on December 1, 2022.

Chad was born on September 11, 1969, in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, to Frank and Linda Williams, who preceded him in death. He graduated from Faith Community Christian High school in Pittsburgh, PA, in 1988. Chad went on to earn a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree and founded a thriving company, EMS Management and Consultants, Inc.

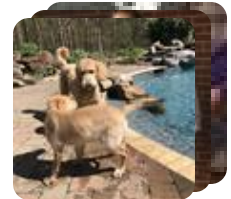

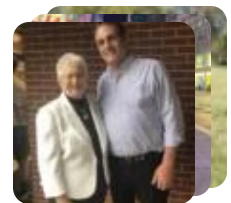

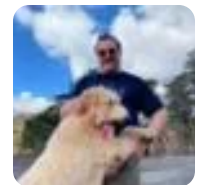
