Jeannette Christine Gedney, née Halcin, was born on April 16, 1943, in Beaver Falls, PA to Steve and Mary Halcin, née Stolar. She departed this earthly life on Sunday, December 11, due to chronic lung disease. She was the youngest of 4 sisters and 1 brother who passed in his youth. Jeannette loved spending time with her sisters who, when they were all together, would laugh until their bellies hurt.

After graduation from Ambridge High School, she began working at Alleghany Airlines as a flight attendant where she met a co-worker and her future husband, Harry Webster Gedney. After their marriage in 1965, they moved to Northern Virginia where they had two sons, Kevin and Bryan, who she adored and loved with all her heart. Jeannette held a variety of jobs while in the D.C. area. She was a Clerk at Value Engineering (now VSE), a Diet Counselor at Diet Center, an Assistant Manager at Wolftrap Motel in Vienna, a Marketing Director for a credit card manufacturer, and a Marketing Director at Sunrise Retirement Center. 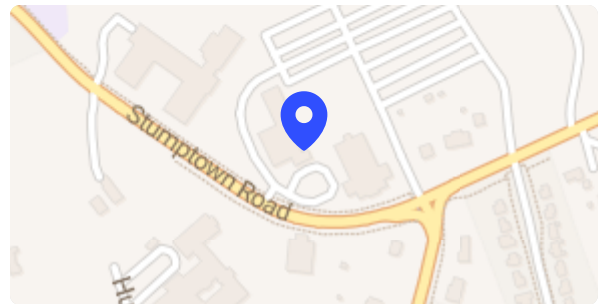

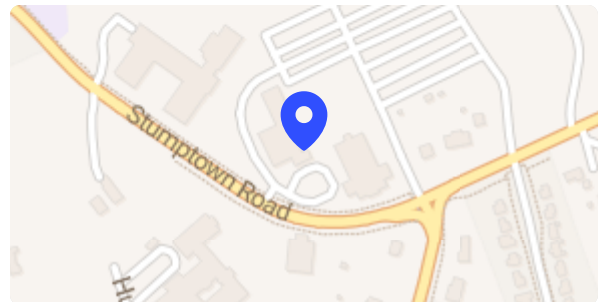

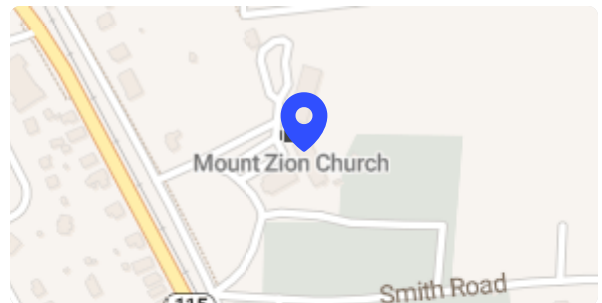
