Nathalie Diana Hanchett-Crissy, 54, passed away on Tuesday April 25, 2023. After unexpectedly being diagnosed with Pancreatic cancer just 6 weeks prior, she decided that at home with family would be her last earthly place of sanctuary.

Nathalie was born March 29, 1969 in Hornell, New York and was a graduate of Hornell Senior High School. A job opportunity took her to Los Angeles for several years, was married in 1999 in San Diego eventually moving back to New York to start and raise her family.

At her core, Nathalie loved being a mother. Nurturing by nature, birthdays, holidays and special occasions were always celebrated with fanfare creating indelible memories. That innate, caring mindset extended to the community as she also worked in the school district as a Teacher's Assistant and Librarian Assistant in Avon NY. As a believer in Christ, she possessed foremost an unshakeable faith. Attending Women of Faith conferences and volunteering at summer youth Bible camps were all intertwined with her values on life. When asked if she was afraid of her diagnosis, she simply pointed upwards towards the heavens and stated "No – He's got me."

Nathalie consistently exuded a positive outlook and started each day sending out messages to her circle. They were funny, encouraging and will be deeply missed by the recipients. Random acts of kindness were also second nature as she'd always making an extra plate of food, taking it to a neighbor or sending out a "just because" card or gift. Her selfless approach was complimented by a determined mindset, elegance and sharp wit when appropriate. Fun loving by nature, she possessed a smile that lit up any room but was always careful to not make herself the center of attention. To quote a recent acquaintance of ours, "She is so vibrant and radiates human decency".

She was pre-deceased recently by her beloved son, Gabriel David (2022) and her father, Leroy George Hanchett (2006). Survivors include her husband, Luke David and daughter, Isabella Rose of Denver, North Carolina; mother Mercedes (Edward) Hanbach of New York; sister Erika Green (Steve) of Texas and a brother James of South Carolina.
