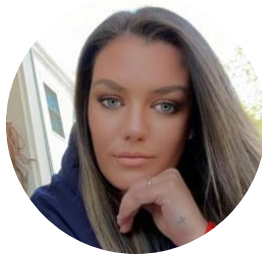


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Dana Marie Lempp, 35, of Cornelius, N.C. made her journey home to our heavenly father on Sunday, May 21, 2023.
