Gloria was born on May 2, 1934, the daughter of German immigrants from the Saxon city of Magdeburg. She grew up in the Ridgewood section of Brooklyn. As a child, Gloria enjoyed many pursuits, including mastering the piano accordion, learning the German language, and singing with the Brooklyn Boys and Girls Chorus, most notably, for their 75th anniversary concert in New York City. Gloria also loved dancing: a requirement for her husband-to-be was that he must dance!

Upon graduation from Bushwick High School, Gloria went to work for Shields & Company, a Wall Street Brokerage firm. She was promoted several times and eventually was promoted to Executive Secretary to the founder of the firm, Paul V. Shields.
