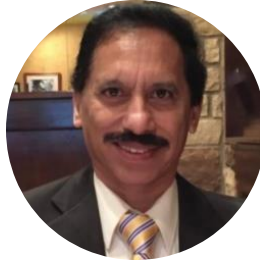

John Jacob was born on November 30, 1953, in Adoor Thatta, Kerala, to the late Kochukoshy Jacob and Ponnamma Jacob.

John was one of seven siblings, brothers Koshy Jacob, Mathew Jacob, Philip Jacob, George Jacob and sisters Mariyamma Jose, and Aleyamma Kurian. In his youth, John excelled as a track and field athlete, demonstrating the exceptional athletic talent that he's carried throughout his life.

After completing his schooling, John joined the Indian Navy, where he served his country with honor and distinction for 10 years. His time in the Navy instilled in him a strong sense of discipline and work ethic, qualities that continued to guide him in all aspects of his life.

John immigrated to the United States in 1984. In 1985, he married Susan Jacob, and God abundantly blessed them to lead a happily married life for 38 years. Together, they raised their two sons, Jason Jacob and Shawn Jacob, and built a cherished home in Charlotte, North Carolina.

While settling in the United States, John transitioned into the banking sector, where his intelligence, hard work, and consistency propelled him through a successful 32-year career at Wells Fargo.
