# **Ann Miller Eytcheson**

**A**nn Miller Eytcheson (nee Watson), born July 23, 1941, in Uniontown, PA lost her battle with Lewey Body Dementia on September 7, 2024, in Huntersville, NC at the age of 83. She passed peacefully surrounded by loved ones by her side and even in her final moments she embodied grace, dignity, unwavering will, and the deep love for family for which she was known.

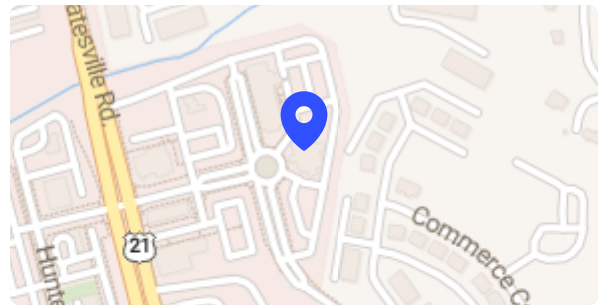

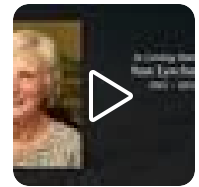

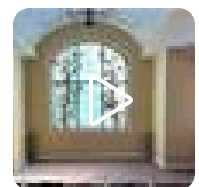
