**O**ur beloved Myron Alice Ingram, 93, passed away November 5, 2024. Her selfless love and generosity touched countless lives, and her unwavering devotion to God, and to her family and friends was the hallmark of her extraordinary life. All who knew her loved her. She will be sorely missed.

Myron was born on June 26, 1931, in Blacksburg, South Carolina, to Mack and Isabell Martin. She was the youngest of eight children. In 1986, she married Michael K. 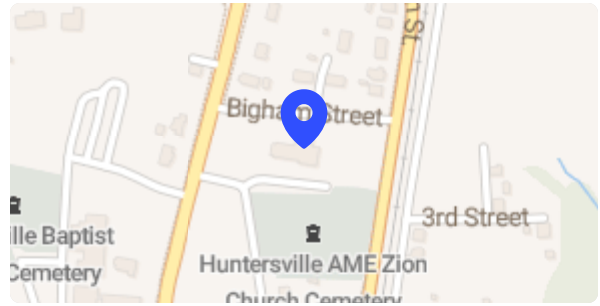
