Kimball Irwin Jones, of Huntersville, North Carolina, died on Sunday, March 9, 2025, at home. He was born on March 16, 1952, to the late Richard M. Jones and Marilyn Jean (Irwin) Jones, in Jamestown, New York.

Kimball graduated from The William Hood Dunwoody Industrial Insitute in Minnesota and Jamestown High School. In his late 40s, attended Jamestown Community College and SUNY Fredonia, where he earned a degree in Education, and attended SUNY Buffalo State for graduate work. 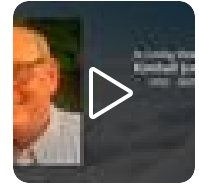
