James Funeral Home, of Huntersville, is serving the family and obituary lovingly written by the family.



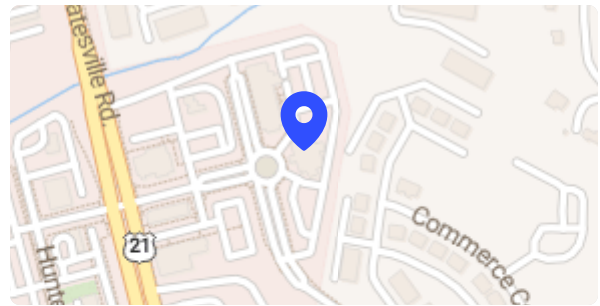

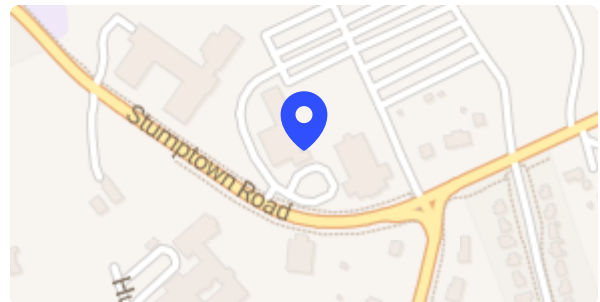

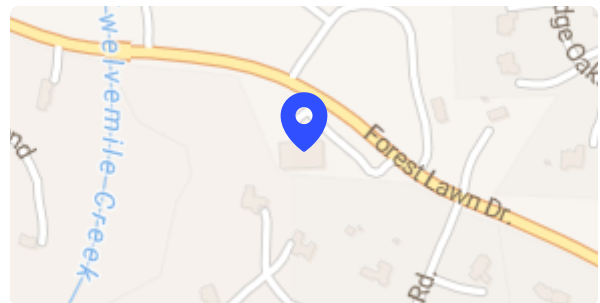
