She was preceded in death by her husband Frank Locke, daughters Cindy, Patty, and Vonnie.

Survivors include daughter Sandy (Jimmy) Winders, 8 grandchildren, 12 great grandchildren, and 3 great great grandchildren.

Joan grew up in Greenville, PA, graduated from Penn High School, and married Frank Locke in 1950. She was a stay-at-home mom and was fiercely devoted to her family. 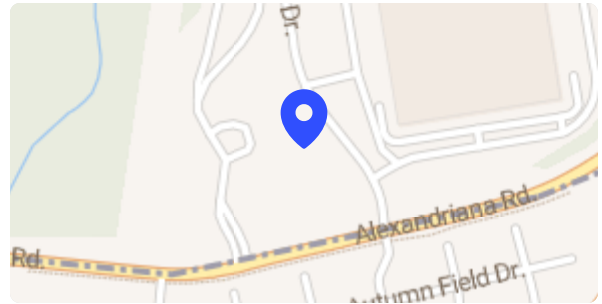

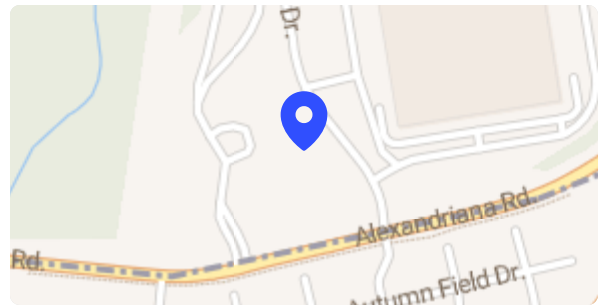
