Yvonne Bost Byers, 98, of Davidson, NC passed on to her heavenly home Sunday, September 28, 2025, surrounded by her family. She was the eldest daughter of John M. Bost and Norma White Bost and was born at Presbyterian Hospital in Charlotte on July 24, 1927. As the oldest of five brothers and sisters, Yvonne grew up in Cornelius attending Cornelius School. She married her high school sweetheart, Edgar Dean Byers (Edd) in May 1945. Following his military service and graduating from Union Seminary in Richmond, Virginia, they began their ministry in the Presbyterian Church serving churches in Goldsboro, North Carolina, Effingham, South Carolina, Hinesville, Georgia and Raleigh, North Carolina.
