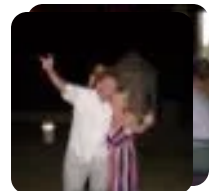

Tom gave me the opportunity to move into Document Handling. The pictures are from one of many industry events. Tom said wait a minute Bart I need to use the prayer booth.

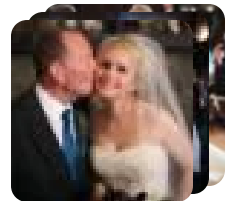

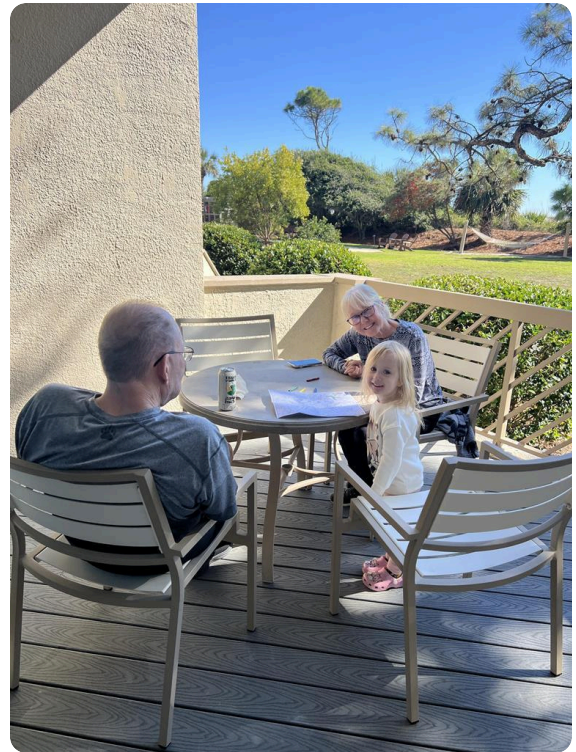
